Student Projections Updates

With the 2023-24 reporting release, MO DVT will now provide student projections two years out in addition to one year out. For example, a student who last tested in fifth grade will now have a projection for sixth grade as well as seventh grade. Student projections are available to users who have Student Report access.

Redesign of Scatterplot Reports

The new scatterplot design emphasizes accessibility, aesthetic appeal, and user-friendliness. Using a similar design to the Growth and Outcomes by Group Reports, the filter panel on this report provides options for users to compare two variables for a selected test, subject, and year. This redesign also includes a download functionality, enhanced comparison features, and the ability to add or remove specific groups of data on the graph. Grades 5 and 8 Science Updates

Starting in the 2023-24 reporting year, Science (Grades 5 and 8) will be included in MO DVT reporting.

High School EOC Updates

Starting in the 2023-24 reporting, high school EOC subjects (Algebra I, Biology, English II, Government) will:

- have Expected Performance Percentile measures available on the Growth Reports.
- be included in the Outcomes by Group Reports.
- have Past Expected measures available in the Student Reports.
- have the Performance axis available as an option on the Scatterplot Report.
